North Sweden European Office cordially invites you to participate in a seminar on “*Active Forest Management in Sweden and its role in contributing to the EU 2050 climate target*”. In its ‘Political Guidelines for the next European Commission 2019-2024’, the European Commission proposes to establish the European Green Deal which will include the first European Climate Law to enshrine the 2050 climate neutrality target into law. The Green Deal will also propose extending the Emissions Trading System EU ETS to new sectors and it will present a new strategy for green financing and a Sustainable Europe Investment Plan that will support €1 trillion of investment over the next decade.

Keynote speakers will address the future EU climate law and EU ETS and related topics such as climate benefits of the Swedish Forest and the European Commission’s proposal to set up a taxonomy to facilitate sustainable investments, as well as showcase the forest-based bioeconomy as a tool in the transition to climate neutrality and future possibilities and untapped biomass resources in Northern Sweden.
